Dear Secretary Bose:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act ("ICA") and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC" or "Commission"), SFPP, L.P. ("SFPP") submits for filing the following tariff, effective February 3, 2021:

- FERC Tariff No. 202.2.0, committed rate tariff covering interstate transportation from El Paso and Diamond Junction, Texas, to the Annex Terminal, Tucson, Arizona (SFPP's "East Line"). The Tariff cancels FERC Tariff No. 202.1.0.

SFPP presents FERC Tariff No. 202.2.0 as a filing under 18 C.F.R. § 342.3(a) to reduce SFPP's committed rate on the East Line below the current ceiling levels applicable to such rate in accordance with the underlying transportation services agreement.

SFPP requests special permission to submit FERC No. 202.2.0 on less than one days' notice under authority of 18 C.F.R. §341.14 and §341.2, in order to have the reduced rates go into effect on February 3, 2021. SFPP submits that good cause exists for granting this request because permitting FERC No. 202.2.0 to become effective on less than one days' notice will benefit its shippers because it will permit SFPP to begin offering a lower rate to shippers as soon as possible. SFPP acknowledges that this tariff publication is conditionally accepted subject to refund pending a thirty-day review period.
