RE: Withdrawal Notice SFPP, L.P. FERC Tariff No. 194.19.1

Dear Secretary Bose:

In accordance with the provision of 18 CFR § 341.13(a), of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC" or "Commission"), SFPP, L.P. ("SFPP") hereby withdraws FERC Tariff No. 194.19.1, issued May 12, 2021 with a proposed effective date of June 11, 2021. The withdrawal is effective June 1, 2021 the date of filing of this withdrawal notice.

SFPP worked with several of its jet fuel shippers ("Airlines") to tailor a limited and temporary exception to SFPP's current proration policy to address the Airlines' concerns with their ability to meet jet fuel demand at certain airports. FERC Tariff No. 194.19.1 proposed a temporary exception to SFPP's proration policy that was limited to the allocation of New Shipper capacity. However, given the protest filed by a number of SFPP's other shippers, SFPP is withdrawing the tariff filing.
